## More Information

- Demonstrators are expected to be set up throughout the entirety of the festival, unless special arrangement has been made with the festival committee. **Hours run from Saturday, September 26 from 9AM-6PM and Sunday, September 27 from 1030AM-4PM.**
- Demonstrators may check in to the festival on Friday afternoon from 3PM-7PM to receive their assigned sites. Set-up can occur Friday between 3p-7p, or between 8a-9a on Saturday and Sunday at 9AM. If you need accommodations outside of these times, please make these arrangements with Volitta at [parks@morgancounty.in.gov](mailto:parks@morgancounty.in.gov).
- Vehicles must be moved out of the festival grounds during festival hours. We will ask that all vehicles be moved by 15 minutes prior to festival opening each day.
- Please be advised that while we will provide security Saturday night, Morgan County Parks is not liable for your site. Please secure it when you are not in attendance.
- At this time, we are unable to provide wi-fi, water, ice, or electricity. There is a gas station with an ATM and an ice machine within a few minutes' drive of the festival.
- If you are a new demonstrator, you may be asked to provide pictures of your set up and dress.
- This event is rain or shine.
- Demonstrators must remove all trash and debris at the close of the event.
- Fire pits are only to be dug-in with the sod replaced afterwards, or on-ground.
- Quiet hours start at 9PM each night.
- This is a family-oriented, community event. Displays and products should be appropriate for all ages. No profanity, suggestive language, or products supporting intolerance towards another group will be allowed.
- If you wish to host a trade blanket, you are welcome to, within your encampment. If you are interested in being a historic vendor (with a tent, etc), you will need to pay the \$10 vendor fee.
- **Applications are due by September 7, 2020.**

## Park Rules

- The sale or use of alcohol is not permitted at this event, unless sanctioned by the Morgan County Parks Department.
- Smoking is not allowed in any building or structure—including temporary structures during events.
- All pets must be leashed at all times and any waste must be immediately removed.
- Weapons, including firearms, are not to be used at the park, excepting historical reenactments during park-sponsored programs.
- Fireworks and other projectiles are not permitted.
- Parking is only permitted in designated areas.
- No fire building is permitted, except by permit of the Morgan County Parks Department.
